## **University Admission – Academic Year 2015/2016 Foreign Candidates (Internal)**

Applications are invited up to **30/07/2015** from eligible foreign Bhikkhus and male lay students under 28 years of age who have obtained at least one of the following qualifications to read for the Bachelor of Arts Degree as internal students.

- **Minimum Requirements for Admission :**

1. G.C.E Advanced Level Examination with Pali, Buddhism and any related subjects recommended by the selection committee.
  2. Any Equivalent Examination to G.C.E Advanced Level Examination in Sri Lanka and it should be certified by the relevant Ministry / High Commission / Embassy.
  3. Diploma in Buddhism/Pali conducted by the Buddhist and Pali University of Sri Lanka or equivalent qualification.
- ❖ Those who have 'Pali' qualification in admission must follow Pali as a compulsory subject whereas others can select any 3 subjects including Buddhist culture and Buddhist philosophy.
  - ❖ Those who do not have Pali qualification in admission have to pass the Compulsory Pali Paper for Qualifying the B.A Degree.
